CHED Memorandum Order No. 30, s. 2005

Rescission of CHED Memorandum Order No. 62,s.1997 providing the Guidelines Implementing the Study Grant Program for Barangay Officials and Their Legitimate Dependents To Implement Section 393, Paragraph 4 of the Local Government Code

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission under Republic Act No. 7722, known as "The Higher Education Act of 1994", Commission En Banc Resolution No. 416-2005 dated August 8, 2005 and upon the recommendation of the Presidents of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) during a national consultation held last August 4, 2005 in Bayview Park Hotel concerning the scholarship grant to the barangay officials and their dependents mandated under Section 393 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Commission hereby rescinds/revokes CHED Order No. 62 s. 1997 on the "Guidelines Implementing the Study Grant Program for Barangay Officials and Their Legitimate Dependents to Implement Section 393, Paragraph 4 of the Local Government Code." Thus, the respective Governing Boards of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) shall be the implementing agencies for Section 393, Paragraph 4 of the Local Government Code.
